Professors Fabio Arcangeli, Patrizio Mulas, and Mirella Milioto of the University of Rome Guglielmo Marconi (Rome, Italy).

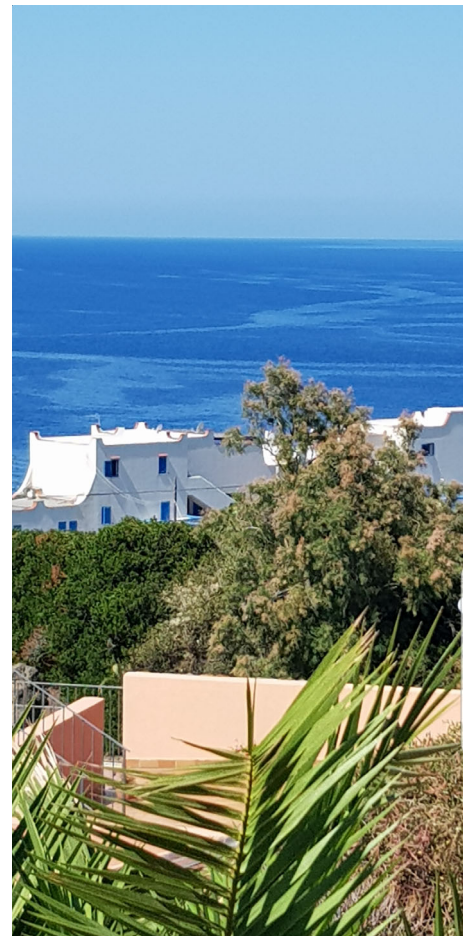

This traditional annual meeting represents the most important interactive event involving experts in Dermatological and Pediatric Sciences in the Mediterranean Region under the Presidency of





Dr. Fabio Arcangeli discussed with the audience several important issues including:

1. A simplified algorithm for the treatment of Acne in Pediatric age;
2. A simplified algorithm for the treatment of Atopic Dermatitis in Pediatric Age.
3. What is new in the treatment of cutaneous vascular lesions in Pediatric Age.

New concepts and new treatments were discussed with the audience, including the introduction of the new systemic approaches with cytokines and monoclonal antibodies.

Dr. Giuseppe Ruggiero shared with the audience the critical aspects of several intriguing clinical cases coming from his Clinical practice and the relationship between obesity and skin and systemic disorders in Pediatric Age.

Dr. Mirella Milioto discussed the many faces of bullous diseases and the new treatments in childhood and adolescence. Dr. Milioto introduced also the new and emerging treatments for scabies and tinea in Pediatric Age.

Dr. Torello Lotti discussed the new and emerging data in the field of Microbiota/Microbiome in skin diseases and the possible therapeutic management.


Treatments could start from the prescription of prebiotics/probiotics and reach the fecal transplants techniques. Dr. Lotti also

shared data and hypotheses on the critical use of the low dose cytokines and growth factors in the treatment of common Pediatric Dermatoses.

Dr. Patrizio Mulas and Dr. Alfonso Delgado Rubio discussed the delicate issue of how to recognize and report to the Authorities suspicious cases of sexual abuse in childhood. Dr. Mulas presented an amazing simplified algorithm for fungal infections in childhood and Dermatologic Disorders & Sport Activities.

Dr. Mirco Pierleoni shared with the audience his personal experience of dermatoscopy in different skin disorders in childhood and the peculiar diagnostic algorithms compared to the adult population. Psoriasis in Pediatric Age and selected clinical cases were also discussed with the audience with special emphasis on the therapeutic management. During the 10th Pediatric Dermatology Congress in Pantelleria Island some important announcements were made:

1. The University Master of Dermatology for Pediatricians 2019–2021 chaired by Professors Torello Lotti, Fabio Arcangeli and Paolo Amori is opened for inscriptions.
